THE PROBLEM

Substance abuse steals futures before they start

Too many young people face pressure, idle time, and stigma—with too few safe places to practise healthier choices. We meet that urgency with advocacy, skills, and community roots—not spectacle.

- Peer pressure without peer support
- After-school hours with nowhere to belong
- Families afraid to ask because of stigma

Stipended Hubs run Champions Clubs and Pathways sessions weekly—Yard Day is a showcase, not the whole story.

Own

Corporates and individuals sponsor named themes with clear roles and a spend trail—contribute, get involved, own the cause.

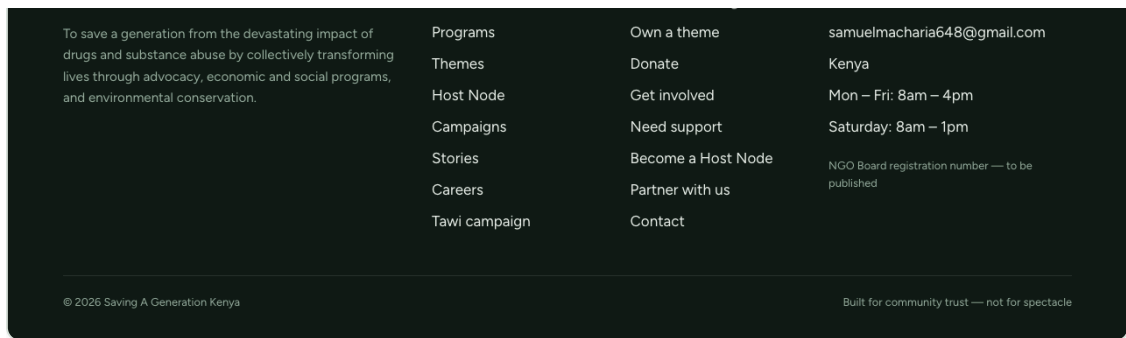

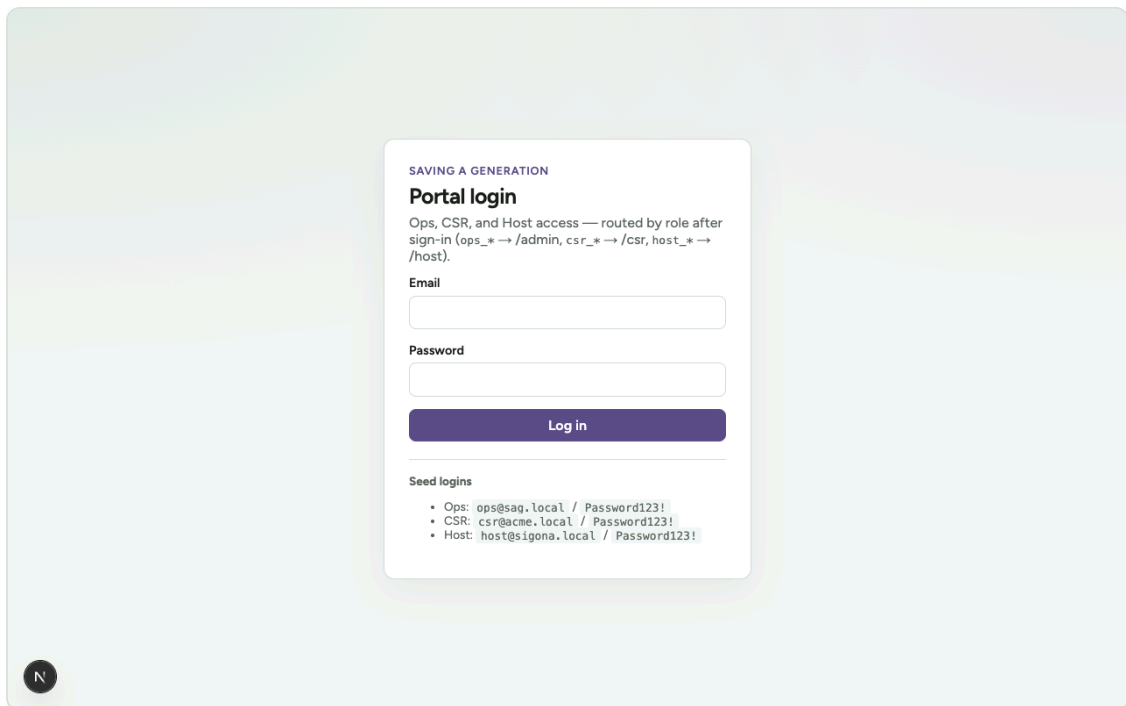
Split by audience

- **Givers:** public-sponsor (themes → donate).
- **CSR prospects:** public-csr → later csr-sponsor if accounts exist.
- **Host prospects:** public-host → later host-node (safeguarding first).

3

Portals login (shared)

Show :3001/login once, then log out between roles so tenant walls stay clear.



10 — Portals login · switch accounts deliberately.

4

Host room

Safeguarding → home → MoU / themes. Say explicitly: Hosts never see Need support.

5

CSR room

Home → profile → team. Say explicitly: CSR never sees Need support or ops support queue.

6

Ops room (staff only)

Inbox vs **support queue** as two stories. Verify a node; glance at audit. Keep family data off shared screens when possible.

7

Families session (optional, private)

Need-support alone. No donate pitch. Schedule separately from Host/CSR demos.

⚠ Room rules

- **Never show Need support** (/need-support or /admin/support) in Host or CSR workshops.
- **Clear auth between roles** — log out; do not reuse tabs with the wrong JWT.
- **Print quick-ref pages** — last page of each manual laminates well.
- **Screenshots missing?** Run `npm run screenshots` with API + both Next apps up.
