Explain what a Host Node is, expectations, and community role — without diving into ops verify tools yet.



PRODUCT

Host Node

A verified venue where youth meet weekly — and sponsors own named themes.

WHAT YOU ARE ADOPTING

Not an idea — a named offer

Saving A Generation packages named themes on faith and school host nodes. The host contributes venue and community workers; SAG raises corporate and individual sponsors and stewards the spend.

Operating rhythm: Twelve-week Champions Club with Pathways woven from week one — peer belonging first, next-step purpose alongside. Yard Day is a showcase, not the ignition.

HOST CONTRIBUTES

Venue and people

- Venue and calendar (e.g. Youth Hall / Saturday rhythm)
- Community workers and a Hub candidate from church-side adults
- Pastoral oversight of branding and photos on church property

HOST DOES NOT

- Fund the pilot programme spend
- Hunt corporate sponsors
- Hand over clinical or rehab responsibility to SAG

SAG CONTRIBUTES

Sponsors and stewardship

- Find CSR and individual theme sponsors
- Pay Hub stipend and programme costs from raised funds
- Provide Club + Pathways rhythm, safeguarding policy, and progress trail
- Match themes only after host review / MoU

HOW IT WORKS

From MoU to playbook

01

Adopt the product

Session agrees Host Node roles: venue + workers; SAG sells themes.

02

MoU

Named days, Hub process, safeguarding, photos, fund flow, press, exit.

03

Choose themes

Parish picks from the theme menu — open choice, not a forced SKU.

04

SAG sells

CSR and individuals own the chosen themes; funds land for that node.

05

Run the term

12-week Club + Pathways with a stipended Hub.

06

Playbook out

Sigona proves the model for hosts outside this network.

THEME MENU

Parish chooses — SAG sells

Open options for the host. After MoU intent, pick one or more; SAG takes them to corporates and individuals.

- Pathways & purpose — Career / skills sessions; Tawi when ready
- Mentor stipend fund — Keep the Hub paid for the term

- Safe yard / venue readiness — Shade, water, storage
- Digital literacy for purpose — Devices + facilitated sessions

- Creative / arts resilience — Workshops as belonging
- Advocacy / awareness day — Invite into the weekly club
- Yard Day Takeover — Showcase day for a running club
- Family helpdesk — Soft brand; dignity-first guidance
- Seedling nursery enterprise — Youth-run micro-enterprise

BOUNDARIES

Clear about what this is not

- Not an open marketplace — hosts are reviewed; themes fund verified nodes.
- Not rehab or clinical care — we facilitate prevention and Pathways; referrals stay with vetted partners.
- Not a takeover of parish pastoral programmes — existing support gatherings remain parish-owned.
- Families needing help: Need support — separate from this product.

HOST NODES

Register your group

Churches, schools, CBOs, and youth groups register to become host nodes and state their activities. Sponsors own themes on verified nodes — we facilitate the match.

HOW IT WORKS

Register → review → match

This is not an open marketplace. Every registration is reviewed for mission fit and safeguarding readiness before you enter the match pool. Public fundable listing comes after Host MoU when a theme buyer is ready.

- Submit group details and the activities you run or want to run.
- SAG reviews fit, duplicates, and safeguarding readiness.
- We match reviewed hosts to CSR and individual theme owners.

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What comes next (say aloud)

After ops review and access, hosts log into :3001, acknowledge safeguarding, then complete MoU and themes. Demo account: `host@sigona.local` — full steps in the [Host portal manual](#).

⚠ Common mistakes

- **Opening Need support** — Host prospects must not see family intake.
- **Skipping the product story** — do not jump straight to portal MoU without context.
- **Promising verified status on day one** — verification is an ops step after onboarding.
